M.A. Degree - normative time is four semesters (36 credit hours)

Basic Requirements (15 hours)

- ___ Proseminar
- ___ Graduate Logic
- ___ Ancient I or Ancient II
- ___ Modern I or Modern II
- ___ Foundations of Analytic Philosophy ___ or Epistemology ___

Additional Requirements (21 hours)

- ___ of 15 required hours, chosen from the following list, in any combination.
 - * Ethical Theory ___,
 - * whichever of Foundations of Analytic Philosophy or Epistemology has not yet been taken. ___
 - * 6000-level seminars taken on a graded basis. (Number of credit hours: ___)
 - * an additional history course from among Ancient I or II or Modern I or II. ___
- ___ of 6 additional hours of graduate course work in philosophy

Portfolio Requirement – for advancement to the Ph.D. Stage of the Program

- ___ two papers to be submitted on the Friday before exam week of the semester in which the M.A. is completed.

Ph.D. Degree - normative time is six semesters after the M.A. (90 credit hours, including M.A. hours)

Course work (54 hours)

Breadth Requirement – Basic Requirements for the M.A., plus (from courses not taken for the Basic M.A. requirement):

- ___ whichever of Foundations of Analytic Philosophy ___ or Epistemology ___ remains to be taken
- ___ either one 6000 level history seminar or one course from among Ancient I or II or Modern I or II.
- ___ Ethical Theory

Advanced Requirements

- ___ of 18 required hours of 6000-level graded seminars (including seminars taken for the M.A.)
- ___ of 3 required and 12 allowed hours of Dissertation Proposal Research
- ___ of 12 required and 20 allowed hours of Dissertation Research
- ___ hours of additional graduate course work in philosophy
- ___ 6000-level seminars taken on S/U basis (one per semester after admission to candidacy, after the graded 6000-level seminar requirement is fulfilled, unless a course is being taken that semester to satisfy the Breadth Requirement)

Dissertation

- ___ Ph.D. Dissertation Proposal
- ___ Demonstration of Language Proficiency, if required by Dissertation topic: required ; not required
- ___ Ph.D. Qualifying Examination and Admission to Candidacy: Public Oral Defense of the Dissertation Proposal
- ___ Ph.D. Dissertation (typically 150-250 pages)
- ___ Ph.D. Dissertation Public Oral Defense
