### For Students Entering the Program *without* a prior M.A

---

#### **M.A. Degree** - normative time is four semesters

- Semester 1: Proseminar  
Graduate logic  
One additional course – see program checklist
- Semester 2: Basic and Additional Requirements
- Semester 3: Basic and Additional Requirements
- Semester 4: Basic and Additional Requirements  
Complete the M.A. – under special circumstances, a student may petition the Graduate Committee for an extension to this deadline. Under no circumstances may more than one extension be permitted

#### *Portfolio Requirement – for advancement to the Ph.D. Stage of the Program*

- \* two papers must be submitted to the Graduate Committee on the Friday before exam week of the semester in which the M.A. is completed

#### **Ph.D. Degree** - normative time is six semesters after the M.A.

- Semester 5: Breadth and Advanced course requirements – see program checklist  
Form a Dissertation Committee – director and 3 additional members, one from outside the department.  
Dissertation proposal research
- Semester 6: Finish Breadth and Advanced course requirements  
Dissertation proposal research  
Deadline for demonstration of language competency, if required by dissertation topic  
Ph.D. Qualifying Examination and Admission to Candidacy: Public Oral Defense of the Dissertation Proposal -- Deadline for taking this examination is the end of the sixth semester of full-time enrollment
- Semester 7: Dissertation research
